Our invited performer for July 21 will be the inestimable **Joe Domitrowich**. Not since 2014 has Joe brought his ethnic blend of cultural influences from Hungary, Croatia and Slovenia to our club. Don't miss his "Capricious Accordion" program to be performed for our July get-together.

As usual, find us in the Millbrae-Chetcuti Community Center on the third Sunday of the month, **July 21st**. It is the place to connect with like-minded accordion enthusiasts, visit with friends from near and far, and support our club. We know summer schedules are full, and traffic can be challenging. But once you get there, you will find ample, convenient parking and more importantly, a gaggle of like-minded accordion enthusiasts!

Bring your accordion and bring your jam vibe, since the meeting will begin at 2:00 pm with a **jam session**, followed by some snacking and social time, and finally the distinctively European sounds of **Joe Domitrowich** in the 2nd half of our program.

Discounted CAF tickets will be for sale at the meeting (see page 8 for details), and as usual, we will have door prize drawings and our scholarship-fundraising raffle. We look forward to seeing you!

Joe Domitrowich has a penchant for technically challenging arrangements and an interest in diverse genres of music. With a youth steeped in Euro-ethnic polka music, Joe's interests later evolved into a passion to arrange specifically for the architecture of digital accordion, and to perform live on solo accordion, musical arrangements derived from classical to contemporary genres that are often associated with other musical instrumentation or with an entire band or orchestra.

Joe delights and surprises audiences with entertaining arrangements of familiar selections – from

Strauss to Santana - that, while often unusual for the accordion, sound remarkably like the original recordings. All his arrangements are performed 100% live...even capricious performances of unconventional accordion selections ranging from Beatles to big band, latin jazz, or arrangements of pop selections like *Mambo #5*, his signature *Train Ride* – not to mention an occasional provocative spoof - all part of a solo act he has dubbed "Squeeze the Day".

Joe especially enjoys performing for other musicians, and especially accordionists and accordion aficionados, who appreciate the nuances of his ar-

rangements and the manner in which he weaves it all together, integrating the familiar sound of the acoustic accordion's natural reeds alongside the broad selection of diverse MIDI samples. He is happy to describe the subtleties of his technique, sharing with those interested how he skillfully harnesses the features of the MIDI accordion to prepare his witty signature arrangements.

In addition to his solo work, Joe is perhaps best known as leader of the **AlpinersUSA Oktoberfest Band**, the SF Bay Area's premiere Oktoberfest show band, which has toured the country, playing huge festivals from the East to West coasts. 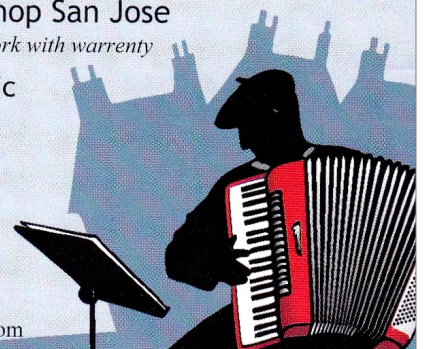

2020 Rose City Accordion Camp to be held at Collins Retreat Center

Next year's Rose City Accordion Camp will be held at the Alton Collins Retreat Center (<https://collins.gocamping.org/>), located approximately 45 minutes by car from the Portland International Airport (PDX).

Collins Retreat Center is in the tall firs and all rooms and camp activities will be under one roof. Are you going to like a bathroom in your room? How about a place to congregate after hours where no one will complain about noise? Have you been dying for 24-hour free coffee service? Camp attendees can expect all of this and "more bang for your buck."
